Dear Pass Holder,

Thank you for purchasing your 2011 pool pass. We are looking forward to a great summer!

We OPEN MONDAY, JUNE 6 THROUGH FRIDAY, AUGUST 26 and offer swim lessons, guard start classes, SCUBA classes, diving lessons, private swim lessons, **private pool parties** and **birthday party packages** and a great concession stand....all summer long.

There are some relatively new additions to our facility this season – including:

- ❖ An AED (Automated External Defibrillator)
- ❖ Pool Drains – in Compliance with the Virginia Graham Baker Law
- ❖ Pool Furniture
- ❖ Diving Board Resurfacing
- ❖ Rescue Equipment
- ❖ ADA Compliant Pool Lift
- ❖ Shoe Racks in Locker Rooms (No outside shoes are allowed on the deck. It's a State Law!)

MANAGERS: Our pool Manager is Brandon Simpson; he will be assisted by Craig Shevchik, Jeanne Ashley, and 2 Head Guards. Karen Owens will again be our Aquatics Coordinator

POOL HOURS / CLOSING POLICY: We intend to keep the pool open from 1pm to 8pm daily – but will close the pool when weather and temperatures dictate. The pool staff will clear the pool at the first sight or sound of thunder or lightening. If the pool stays closed for more than one hour – a decision may be made to close the pool for the remainder of the day. The pool may also close on days when the air temperature is at 70 degrees or below. If attendance drops below 10 patrons the pool may close as well. There are several days when the pool may be closed for special events – we will notify you by posting a sign at the admission desk.

ADULT SUPERVISION: Children under the age of 8 **must** be accompanied by a responsible person over the age of 16 and it is strongly recommended that children 8 and over be accompanied by a responsible person over the age of 16. Our staff will do everything possible to make your swimming experience a safe one – but please help us keep your children safe by watching them closely.

POOL RULES: Please refer to the 2011 Pool Rules on the back side of this letter. We ask that you comply with the rules in an effort to operate a safe and comfortable family swimming facility.

- Please be reminded that no outside food, beverages (exception: bottled water) or coolers are permitted – baby food is an exception.
- All children who are not potty-trained must wear a swim diaper.
The swim diaper must be covered by a bathing suit.
- Please use gender-appropriate locker rooms with school age children.
- LUP&R/RMP reserves the right to refuse admittance.

Babies must wear a swimmy diaper in pool(s)

Floaties Permitted in 2 1/2 ft only - & with adult supervision

Jump Straight off Boards – One on a Board at a time

Not Responsible for Lost or Stolen Articles

All Purchased Food in Concession Area / Big Beach Only

Stay off of the Ropes

Use the Ladder on the same side as the Board
