Latrobe Farmers' Market Vendor 2022 Fresh Vegetable and Fruit Agreement



Thank you for playing such a vital role in our farmers' market! This agreement is between those vendors who are selling fresh vegetables and fruits, and the Latrobe Farmers Market, an affiliate of the Greater Latrobe Parks and Recreation Department for the duration of the 2022 season.

I agree to sell only fruits and vegetables which have been grown by myself or members of my household. I am responsible to visually list any produce at my vendor space, which I have not personally grown or I have purchased from a *local grower*. I understand I will be charged an additional \$20.00 per week for the resale of purchased produce from a primary PA grower. All produce must be grown in Pennsylvania. For instance, purchasing apples and pears from Walmart is prohibited for two reasons 1) it would be grown outside of PA, and 2) it would could from a secondary source (as opposed to the primary grower/party). I agree to a field inspection at any time, by the market manager, to inspect my growing space or ask for photographs of said spaces.
