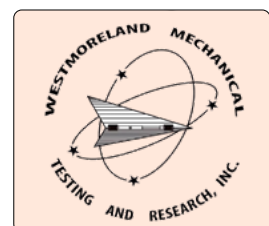

GENERAL RULES FOR PARKS/TRAILS/FIELDS/ COURTS/PAVILIONS

- ▶ Parks are open from Dawn to Dusk
- ▶ No Dogs or Pets *(except on Creekside and Lincoln Trail – must be on leash)*
- ▶ No Alcohol or drugs on/ in Parks/Trails
- ▶ No Smoking or vaping
- ▶ No Profanity
- ▶ No camping or staying overnight
- ▶ No Open Fires
- ▶ No Glass Bottles
- ▶ No Feeding the Wildlife *(Geese, Birds, Squirrels, etc.)*
- ▶ No motorized vehicles: Hover boards, E-Bicycles, E-Scooters etc. *(Except wheelchairs or like devices for special needs/disabilities)*
- ▶ No Metal Detecting or Geo-caching
- ▶ No Hitting Golf balls
- ▶ No Hunting
- ▶ No Firearms or weapons
- ▶ No Dumping Household or Commercial Trash
- ▶ No Excessively Loud or Offensive *(Profanity)* Music
- ▶ No parking vehicles overnight
- ▶ Only Park in designated spaces
- ▶ Bicycles are allowed on Legion Keener path only from 10am to 6pm
- ▶ Skateboards are not allowed on Legion Keener Path or in facilities
- ▶ Skateboards and scooters can use other paths/trails as long as users are not defacing property *(tables, benches, curbs)*
- ▶ Any organized activity, event, lesson, or program not under the parks & recreation umbrella must have permission to use the property and have a permit issued by the department.

Across the street, we are finalizing plans for another much-anticipated update to the historic **Potthoff building**, which is on track to occur this year. Some of the first-floor entrance will be demolished, making way for an all new high glass and metal storefront. This will be installed to better restore this historic gem of a structure which has completed the first phase of being eligible for the Historic Registry of the PHMC. We will also be adding some warm exterior up and down lighting and restoring the left entrance doors.

Across the street at the Latrobe Art Center, as we wish our good friend Rita and her family the best in her well-deserved retirement, we welcome the new restaurant, **Canvas and Crumb Cafe**, to this essential corner of downtown that continues to see continuous improvements and increased activity.

Further up Main Street we are in early phases of planning needed updates to Mozart Hall and will have an update to share later this year.

Speaking of Main Street, another structure with a very rare custom wood exterior known as the Mailey's Provisions building received some much-needed updates through our façade grant program this summer, sealing the exterior of the structure and painting it. The brick columns will now be meticulously repointed by the skilled workers at Raimondo Restoration to ensure this building lasts many more years. While there is seemingly a never ending list of work to be done throughout downtown, we greatly appreciate the responsible building and business owners in Latrobe who are willing to work with our team.

We also just expanded our rentable Vegetable Gardens over at Frogtown Lane near Legion Keener Park. We now have over 70 flower planters that join thousands of other flowers in additional larger planting beds around the city.

In terms of tree upkeep, we will be removing diseased crabapples that have fire blight on the Lincoln Avenue Trail and plan on putting in many new trees in this very important and heavily used area this fall.

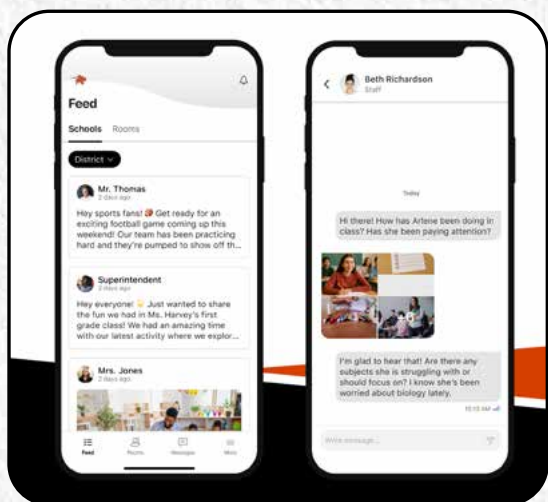
